



## BLUENOSE II IS COMING


Bluenose coming to Sheet Harbour September 18th.


## CASTING OFF

### Personal Watercraft (PWC) i.e. sea-doo's:

- 1-Canadian Approved personal flotation device or lifejacket of appropriate size for each person on board
- 1-floating heaving line minimum 50ft long
- 1-manual propelling device OR an anchor with a 50ft rope or chain
- A watertight flashlight OR 3-Canadian approved flares of Type A, B, or C.
- A sound signalling device, air-horn or whistle
- 1-bailer device OR 1-manual water pump
- 1-Class 5BC fire extinguisher

### Powerboat pleasure craft less than 20' (6m):

- 1-Canadian Approved personal flotation device or lifejacket of appropriate size for each person on board
- 1-floating heaving line minimum 50ft long
- 1-manual propelling device OR an anchor with a 50ft rope or chain
- A watertight flashlight OR 3-Canadian approved flares of Type A, B, or C.
- A sound signalling device, air-horn or whistle
- 1-bailer device OR 1-manual water pump
- 1-Class 5BC fire extinguisher
- Navigation lights
